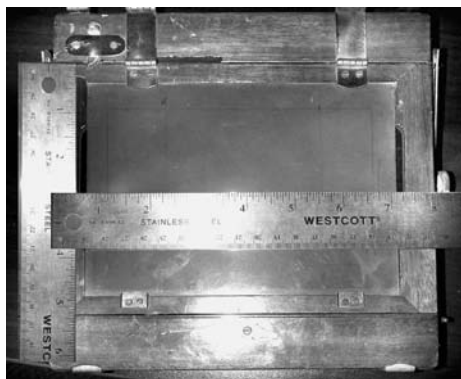

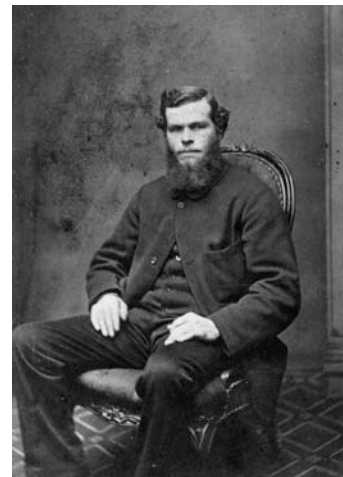

NEEDS HELP

Alexander Globe, a professor at the University of British Columbia is writing a book about the 1858 gold rush on the Fraser River. "I've been trying to identify the photographer of the enclosed albumen print from the carpet, chair, and backdrop. It was taken between 1857 (when photographers started making albumen prints in San Francisco) and 1860 (when the subject died). "The sitter was a gold miner who left California in July 1858 for British Columbia. The photo could have been taken in San Francisco or by an itinerant photographer before July 1858, or else in Victoria during 1859 or 1860. "I've looked everywhere but up to now nobody recognizes the studio." globe@mail.ubc.ca
